2019 LARRY FULLERTON PHOTOJOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIP

The Larry Fullerton Photojournalism Scholarship was established at The Dayton Foundation through contributions from Larry Fullerton's family and friends to assist students pursuing careers in photojournalism. Larry Fullerton was a long-time member of ONPA and both a photojournalist and assistant managing editor of the Hamilton Journal-News.

Two scholarships will be awarded: First place will receive \$3,000 and the runner-up will receive \$2,100. These funds will be deposited with the recipient's university bursar, to be used toward tuition and lab fees. **This scholarship is not associated with the ONPA Student Photographer of the Year competition and eligible students need not be members of ONPA to qualify.**

In order to be eligible a student must meet the following criteria:

- Be a resident of the State of Ohio
- Be an undergraduate student, enrolled full time, returning to school for the fall term of the 2019-2020 school year and attending one of the following:
 - a. An accredited Ohio college or university
 - b. An accredited Ohio junior college offering an associate degree
 - c. A school or institution offering a structured 2-year curriculum
- Have a 2.5 or better cumulative grade point average. Submit copy of transcript
- Submit a portfolio of no fewer than 10 and no more than 15 entries that demonstrate creativity, technical excellence, versatility and the ability to communicate visually. The portfolio should include news, features, sports and environmental portraits and must also have at least one picture story. The picture story shall be no more than 10 images and counts as one entry in the portfolio. (See entry preparation form for guidelines)
- Include a statement discussing your philosophy of photojournalism, current career goals, work experience and financial need.

Hard copies of applications and portfolios must be received by ONPA President Joshua Bickel by:
Friday, MARCH 1, 2019.

JUDGING AND AWARDS

The Board of Trustees of ONPA and their designates will be the judges. Final results will be based upon the judge's recommendations, pending the approval of the Governing Board of The Dayton Foundation. Winning entries become the property of the Dayton Foundation, for archival purposes only.

LARRY FULLERTON PHOTOJOURNALISM SCHOLARSHIP

Submit a portfolio of no fewer than 10 and no more than 15 entries that demonstrate creativity, technical excellence, versatility and the ability to communicate visually. The portfolio must include news, features, sports and environmental portraits and must also include at least one picture story. The picture story shall be no more than 10 images and counts as one entry in the portfolio.

- All entries for the Fullerton Scholarship must be in digital format submitted on CD or USB Drive.
- With the exception of illustration entries, there shall be no digital alteration of any entry.
- All entries must be in RGB mode. The standard is ten inches for the longest dimension at 200 dpi. Save and compress the file using Photoshop JPEG compression set to 6, or medium.
- The image orientation must read in normal viewing position, with top of the image actually being at the top. We will not flop or rotate photographs.
- Unpublished photographs are eligible for entry.
- Do not apply any sharpening to images.
- Save each image with a file name that also serves as a title. Example: Big Catch.jpg. This will also serve as the Object Name in Photoshop's "File Info" dialog. For picture stories, file names should be numbered to reflect the proper viewing sequence. Example: PicStory_01.jpg, PicStory_02.jpg, PicStory_03.jpg, etc.
- Caption information is required and must be attached to the image using Photoshop's "File Info" option (under the file menu). DO NOT use any third party plug-in to attach the caption information. Required fields for entry include: **Caption:** The information about the photo. NOTE: On picture stories, a brief introductory setup about the story will need to be added in this field before the caption and is only required on the first photo, labeled, PicStory01.jpg, **Byline or Author:** Entrants name, **Credit:** School or University you attend, **Creation Date:** Date photograph made, **Object Name:** File name of photo
